Terry Goddard has a long history of supporting issues that are uniquely of great concern to women. As Mayor and Attorney General, Terry has promoted opportunities for women and has been an active voice for key issues of social justice, civil rights, diversity, job security, and education.

Terry's positions on reproductive health are consistent and are clear.

Terry supports Roe vs. Wade and a woman's ability to choose safe and legal abortion.

A lobbyist for the Arizona Catholic Conference (ACC) called 2009 the "most pro-life session ever, saying "(Jan Brewer) signed virtually everything that we were able to get on her desk." The ACC and the Center for Arizona Policy, an Evangelical Christian Organization, proudly noted that it accomplished 10 of their 13 legislative goals in 2009, noting that their biggest wins were three new laws that restrict abortion. Terry is opposed to regulations that interfere with access to care, such as required waiting periods.

Jan Brewer signed into law strict, anti-abortion regulations including a 24-hour waiting period for abortion. (Arizona Republic, August 2, 2009)

Terry opposes restrictions on abortion procedures that fail to provide an exception to protect a women's health.

Terry supports the current law requiring health insurance coverage for contraception.

Terry supports public funding for family planning services for low-income women.

Jan Brewer has used the national spotlight to divert our attention from her actions that undermine and undercut the rights of women in our State.
